

At the heart of the methodology is the fundamental principle that all organizations—like

living organisms—have a natural life cycle, and that they will exhibit predictable and repetitive patterns of behavior as they grow and age. At each new stage of its development, an organization is faced with a unique set of challenges. How well or poorly these challenges are addressed and necessary changes made, ultimately determines the success or failure of that organization.

The Methodology implements precisely defined processes which enable organizations to be both flexible and controllable in the face of accelerated change, while creating an environment of mutual trust and respect among individuals within the organizations themselves.

After three decades of teaching and working in this unique field, it has been effectively demonstrated that Adizes processes are applicable to most organizations. The Methodology works in diverse settings, from start-ups to major global corporations.

SPIRAL DYNAMICS™



Spiral Dynamics is an evolutionary-based framework that provides a scaffolding upon which numerous other theories of management, leadership, motivation, organizational design, communication, and social change can either be built or integrated.

Based on the work of the late Professor Clare W. Graves, Spiral Dynamics maps out specific strategies and tactics for the meshing of healthy systems and clearly demonstrates the root causes of—and solutions to—unhealthy change in societal evolution. This concept illuminates the deep tributaries that produce crossroads in human, organizational and societal development, while identifying specific applications in business, government, religion, education, politics, sports, media, and social transformation.

In live seminars, which take place at the Adizes Graduate School, Dr. Don E. Beck examines the eight levels of human existence in this conceptual and applicable system. In these seminars, he describes *memetics*—a way of understanding the awakening and migration of ideas and life forms and offers a closely woven companion track that covers thinking in sequences and life cycles.
